**Background :**

During the last decades a new sophisticated level of nasal surgery has emerged aesthetic reconstructive rhinoplasty by Burget 1994 and Menick 1999 to achieve a true aesthetic rather than mere improvement natural results this need surgical skills including the use of rib cartilage grafts, this is not a simple primary SRP or revision one.

**Introduction:**

The three Cs cleft, cocaine, and catastrophes to realize the difficulty of both the problems and the correction. I will discuss 2 cases with cleft lip nose and 3 cases with large septal perforation repair and 5 cases with (catastrophe) severely crooked nose.
